

Golden Years cannot care for every applicant who wishes to receive services. Golden Years has certain service limitations due to size, location, composition, staffing and equipment. Golden Years can not care for residents with any of the following diagnoses and/or identified problems:

- Persons on ventilators
- Persons who are registered sex offenders
- Persons with major mental illness diagnoses
- Persons with drug or alcohol dependence
- Persons receiving chemotherapy or other biologicals that may require special monitoring
- Persons who are pregnant
- Persons under the age of 18

Residents and/or Resident Representatives are required to disclose all conditions and diagnoses prior to, or upon admission to our facility. These service limitations will be discussed upon admission. If you fail to disclose any of the above conditions at the time of admission, or one of the above conditions is identified or develops after admission, **Golden Years** may seek to discharge you if we can no longer meet your needs.
